

**Early Childhood Club Minutes**  
**September 21, 2018**

President Ezra Moreno called the meeting to order at 12:32pm. She called the members' attention to the list of community events under "Announcements" on the agenda. Afterwards, the meeting proceeded with New Business. Both Mrs. Flores-Muñoz and Dr. Amy Mintz shared information about the service learning that students in Internship 1 and Internship 2 were participating in this semester. Internship 2 students are collecting gently used children's books for the Little Free Libraries and students in Internship 1 are collecting necessary items for children in foster care; these bags are known as "Sweet Cases". These items will be distributed in duffle bags purchased from Togetherwiser.org. The duffle bags cost \$10 each.

Lucero Escutia made a motion to use club funds to purchase 10 duffle bags (\$100) that will be filled with the donations for these foster children. The motion was seconded by Elizabeth Goodwin. All were in favor. **Motion carried.**

There was discussion as to whether to request a check for the \$100 or to reimburse one of the faculty for the purchase of the duffle bags. Dr. Mintz volunteered to purchase them immediately on the condition of reimbursement. Again, Lucero Escutia made a motion to reimburse Dr. Mintz for this expense. This motion was seconded by Hesper Suniga. All were in favor. **Motion carried.**

Mrs. Flores-Munoz then shared the date and time of the NAEYC Student Interviews and asked for volunteers to attend. Then the group answered typical questions that may be asked during the accreditation visit.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:09 pm.
