



Pan American Round Table of Corpus Christi, Texas SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND FACULTY ENHANCEMENT GRANTS

Criteria for Selection of Scholarship Recipients:

The recipient shall be a person with an interest in fostering mutual understanding among the countries of the Western Hemisphere in the areas of history, culture, language, government, business, and/or the arts.

If the recipient is a graduate or undergraduate student, he/she must demonstrate financial need**.

(**Foreign students who do not fill out Federal Student Aid Forms may submit a signed affidavit to indicate financial need.)

The recipient must be a citizen of the United States or of a country of the Western Hemisphere who intends to return to his/her native country.

If the recipient is a graduate or an undergraduate student, he/she shall be enrolled or intend to enroll in Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi, Texas A&M University-Kingsville, or Del Mar College.

The undergraduate recipient must enroll in a minimum of twelve college credit hours and maintain a 2.5 grade point average or better on a four-point scale. The graduate student recipient must enroll in a minimum of nine graduate college hours and maintain a 2.5 grade point average or better.

Students submit a PAN AMERICAN ROUND TABLE APPLICATION (available at the Development Foundation Office of the college or university), an essay that includes financial need, and reference letter from a faculty member of that institution and a copy of the college/university transcript.

Application Form; 2. Essay; 3. Letter of Recommendation; 4. Academic Transcript; and 5. Resume.**
