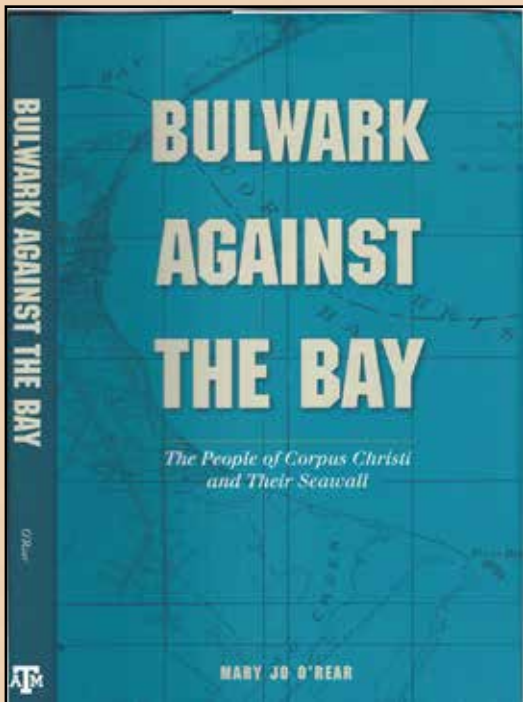


Bulwark Against the Bay
