



The Del Mar College Department of Music invites you to participate in the 2014 Viking Summer Band Camp. The Viking Band Camp centers on the comprehensive music education and artistic advancement of every student. We will provide opportunities for all middle school, junior high, and high school students to collaborate for five days of focused music-making while making new friends and enjoying summer time activities. The Viking Band Camp will include a full Concert Band for middle school and junior high students as well as a Wind Ensemble for high school students. Every participant will also have an opportunity to participate in other ensembles such as Percussion Ensemble, Brass Ensemble, Woodwind Ensemble, Jazz Band, Mariachi, and various Chamber Groups. In addition, the Viking Band Camp will offer elective courses in Conducting, Leadership, Music Appreciation/Theory, and History of Rock and Roll. Students will also have the unique opportunity to learn from many of our professions most reputable musicians and music educators while enjoying various recreational activities and recitals.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Students who have worked diligently on their instrument and were members of the 2014 TMEA All-State Band, or ATSSB All-State Band are eligible to receive a \$50 scholarship. As such, the camp fee for all 2014 All-State Band members is \$125 total. Please note that this scholarship

opportunity must be accepted by June 2, 2014. This scholarship offer is void after June 2 at which time the \$200 camp fee will apply.

*All seniors who are enrolled or planning to attend Del Mar College in the Fall 2014 as a music, or non-music major are highly encouraged and very welcomed to attend the Viking Band Camp at NO COST!

MEALS:

As a part of the Viking Band Camp fee, lunch will be provided for all participants each day of the camp from June 16-20.

Daily meals may include:

Snacks will be available for purchase everyday throughout the week. Please bring some extra money if you would like to purchase additional snacks.

INSTRUMENTS:

Percussion: DMC will provide all percussion equipment. Students are responsible for providing their own sticks and mallets. Brass and Woodwind: All students are responsible for providing their own instrument. If you do not own your own, please make arrangements with your band director BEFORE you arrive at camp.

- **ENSEMBLES:** Students audition for chair placement in the Concert Band (middle school/junior high) and Wind Ensemble (high school) during the first few hours of camp. They are then placed into various ensembles depending on their individual strengths and abilities. Other ensembles include jazz band, brass/woodwind ensembles, percussion ensemble, chamber groups, etc.
- **FACULTY AND STAFF:** Many of our profession's most successful and reputable studio musicians, artists, pedagogues, conductors, and music educators.
- **CONCERTS:** Viking Band Camp concerts will be held in the legendary Richardson Performance Hall on the final day of camp beginning at or near 2:00 p.m.
- **AWARDS:** Band awards will be presented to the "outstanding" camper in each performing ensemble.
- **ACTIVITIES:** Students will participate in daily activities outside of their music-making in the hope of meeting great people and creating new friendships!
- **CAMP SUPERVISORS/COUNSELORS:** A staff of Del Mar College faculty members, college students, administrators and area band directors will serve as camp supervisors and counselors. NOTE: All Viking Band Camp student participants are required to remain on the Del Mar College campus under supervision each day of operation throughout the entire week of camp. There are absolutely no exceptions to this regulation.
