Accepting Completed Application Packets-Deadline: Thursday, January 10, 2008 Noon

Del Mar College and CCAD are partners in the Student Career Experience Program (SCEP) designed to assist CCAD in employing skilled high-tech minded students who will be required to attend Del Mar College at least half time and be willing to work 32 hours per week at CCAD. Eligibility requirements are:

1. Be a U.S. citizen or national (permanent residence in absence of qualified citizenship).
2. Complete and submit Form OF 306 (www.opm.gov, click on Forms, click on Optional Forms, print and complete OF 306. Optional Form 612 can be printed from this web site page.)
3. Must be enrolled for Spring 2008 for a minimum of 6 college credit hours at Del Mar College. (NOTE: Remedial courses do not count toward the minimum semester hours requirement.)
4. Have successfully completed a minimum of 15 college credit hours of electronics courses from any higher education institution whose credit hours are accepted for transfer by Del Mar College.
5. Have a grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 or above when registering for the Student Career Experience Program and continue to maintain a G.P.A. 2.5 or above through graduation from the program.
6. Assessment levels required at application packet deadline: Reading-2, English-2, Math-2.
7. Be willing to work 32 hours per week on the 1st or 2nd Shift and enroll at Del Mar College for a minimum of six college credit hours per semester. (NOTE: Remedial courses do not count toward the minimum semester hours requirement.)
8. Students must successfully complete the A. A. S. degree for avionics within two years upon entry into this Avionics Technology SCEP in order to be converted to a permanent full-time position to the Intermediate grade level of either WG-07 or WG-08.

The CCAD Student Career Experience Program provides an opportunity to gain work experience directly related to a specific field of study; permits students to earn leave credit for illness and vacation; includes health and life insurance options. Students selected under this notice will begin at the WG-05 grade level earning \$17.70 per hour at 32 hours per week. Upon graduation successful job/academic performers can be converted to WG-07 or WG-08 begin working a 40 hour workweek on completion of Associate degree.

Applicants applying for consideration may submit a resume in lieu of the OF 612.

Successful applicants will have to meet the employment requirements of CCAD: Physical and drug screening.
